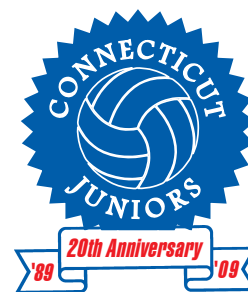

About CT Juniors Tuition

The CJVA is member supported. Tuition goes toward operating expenses including uniforms, insurance, facility rentals, custodial fees, coaches salaries and administrative expenses.

State players have the option of paying the entire \$495 tuition all at once when registering or in 2 installments of \$260. The first installment is due when registering and the second is due at the first tournament.

Refunds less a \$25 processing fee will be granted prior to the registration deadline of Wednesday, December 2nd. After that, refunds will be granted less a \$60 processing fee. Once tryouts start, refunds will be granted on a prorated basis for medical reasons only with a doctor's explanation.

Travel Teams

Grades 7-12

National Team Cost \$1850,
Regional Team Cost \$1250

CT Juniors has one of the most respected travel programs in the east. Many players have received college scholarships. Teams of 10 players will be formed in the following age groups: 18 & Under, 17 & Under, 16 & Under, 15 & Under, and 14 & Under. The cost includes an average of two practices per week, uniforms, warm-ups, coaching fees, USAV membership and event entry fees. It does not include hotels or food. Practices will be held on Sundays and Wednesdays. Tryouts are Sunday, Nov 29th, Monday, Nov 30th, and Wednesday, Dec 2nd from 6-9 pm. There is a \$60 tryout fee that is nonrefundable. The season runs from December to May. 18-U, 17-U, and 16-U teams will be considered "National" teams and will travel to several multi-day tournaments throughout the mid-east/northeast. 15-U and 14-U teams will be considered "Regional" teams and will only compete within the New England Region. Teams will be formed by the end of the 3rd tryout and players will be required to pay for the program immediately following the 3rd tryout. Players have the option of paying the entire tuition on December 2nd or by paying installments of \$900 (\$650 Regional) on Dec 2nd, \$500 (\$325 Regional) due Jan 15th and Feb 15th. Players not making the Travel Program can still play in the State Program. Travel teams will also participate in at least two club fundraisers during the season.

CT Juniors is proud to be the only team from the New England Region invited to participate in a new power league called the Northeast Tournament Series (N.E.T.S.). It will be comprised of only the top clubs in the states of NY, NJ, & PA for the purpose of higher level competition. We are honored by the selection and look forward to the challenge!

State Program

Grades 8-12

Cost: \$495

For players who have played organized middle school, Freshman, J.V., or Varsity volleyball. Tryouts are December 6, 13 & 20. Teams of 9-11 players will be formed based on age and ability. Teams will practice and compete in tournaments against other teams from around the state. Players not selected to a team will be notified after the 3rd tryout and refunded less a \$90 tryout fee. Eighth graders and Freshman not selected to the State Program will have the opportunity to participate in the Developmental Program. Registration deadline is December 2nd or when all tryout facilities are at capacity.

Developmental Program

Grades 5-8

Cost \$335

For players who may be beginners or have had some middle school experience. There are 6 Sunday practices (2 hours each) and 2 Sunday Tournaments (3-4 hours each). Practices will take place at the Woodbridge and Westport locations only. The tournaments will be held at the Connecticut Sports Center in Woodbridge.

The emphasis of the Developmental Program is placed on developing a sound foundation of individual skills such as passing, serving, hitting and defense. Players are taken on a 1st registered basis as long as space permits. There are no tryouts! Registration deadline is December 29th. Practices are Jan. 3, 10 & 24, Feb. 7, 21, & 28. Tournaments are Jan. 31 & Mar. 7. The entire \$335 tuition must accompany the registration application.
